RHEINPREUSSEN FISCHER-TROPSCH PLANT

I Target Identification

The location of the Fischer-Tropsch Plant of the Steinkohlen-Bergwerk Rheinpreussen is shown by Figure 1 page 2. It has been referred to variously as located in Homberg, Homberg-Meerbeck, Moers, and Moers-Meerbeck, of which the last is the most accurate designation. This plant is one of a chain of Rheinpreussen plants identified locally by the number of the mine shaft with which they are associated. South of Homberg, near the Rhine, is the original plant at Shafts I, II and III, and here also is the Main Office of the Company. West of this plant, about half way between Homberg and Moers is a coking plant at Shaft IV. A short distance northeast of Moers is the present target at Shaft V and considerably farther to the northwest is another coking plant at Shaft VI near Lintfort. There is an affiliated plant, Gewerkschaft Neuhühl, a short distance northeast of Duisberg. All Fischer-Tropsch activities were confined to the Moers-Meerbeck plant.

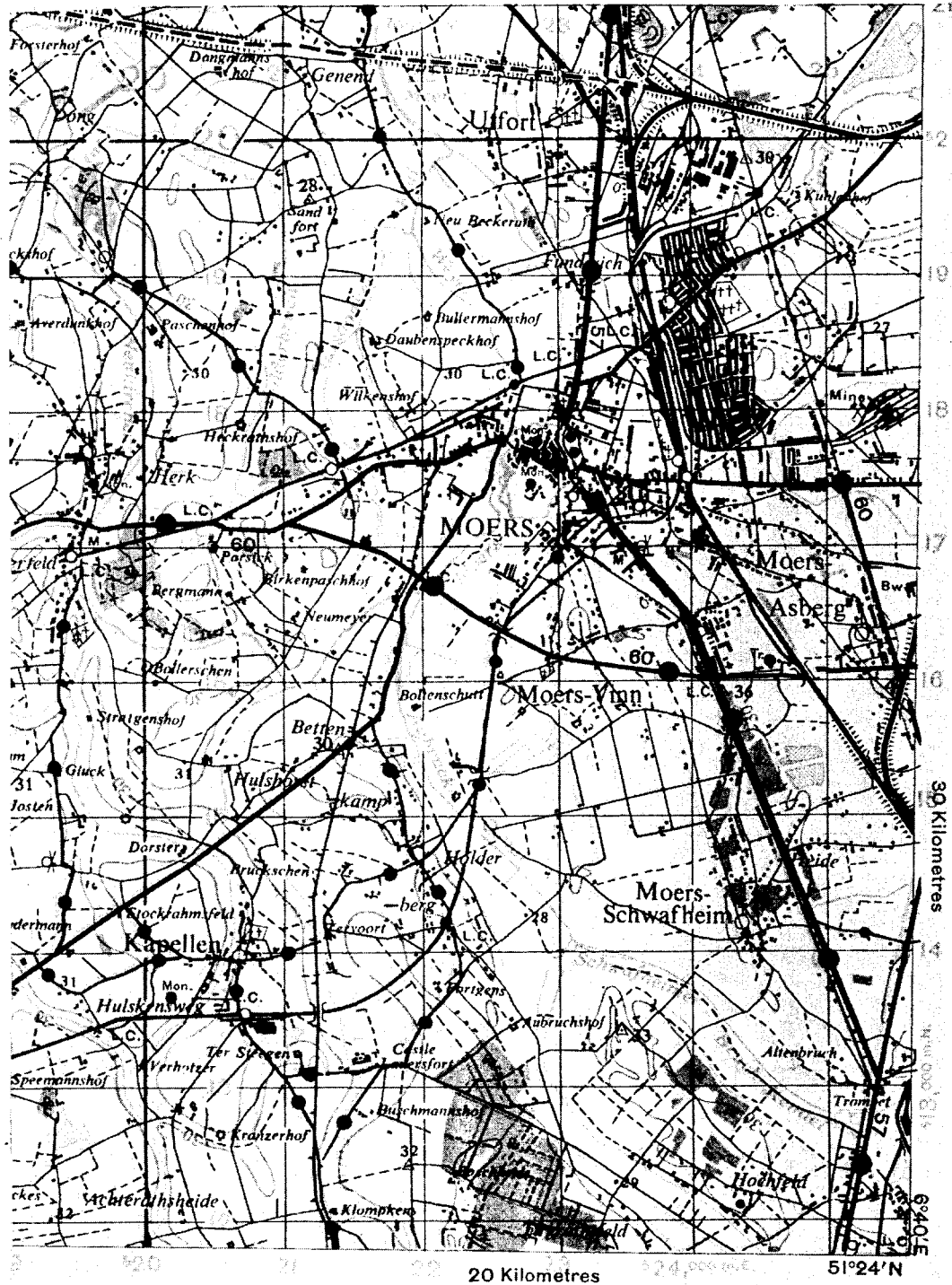


Figure 1
